



## PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

By registering to play for the MPCSC all players are deemed to have read, understood and will therefore abide by the MPCSC Player Code of Conduct and associated leagues.

The player agrees that any breach of this code will result in disciplinary action being taken, as defined in the MPCSC and/as deemed appropriate by the associate league.

Disciplinary action may include suspension and/or de-registration.

- Abide by the Code(s) of Conduct and encourage others to do the same.
- Abide by the rules and spirit of the game
- Abide by the MPCSC Constitution and the competition rules of the associated league.
- Accept and respect the decisions of the match officials and encourage others to do the same
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Act respectfully towards the players and officials of the MPCSC and all opposing clubs
- I will not use or condone the use of offensive language or abusive behaviour at any time or use or condone the use of violent conduct or sexual, racial or any other form of harassment at any time
- Support the principles of Fair Play and Fair Conduct and encourage others to do the same
- Conduct myself in a manner that enhances, rather than injures, the reputation and goodwill of the MPCSC, the associate league and Soccer in general
- Team Captains only: As team captain I will lead by example
- I will Fulfil my playing obligations with the MPCSC and accept responsibility to be a good ambassador for both the club. I will not make any detrimental statements in public (social media, print, radio) in respect to the MPCSC, Player's, Referee's and associated leagues.
